## Tasting Notes:

The Wolpertinger is the Bavarian cousin of our Mr. Jackalope. It is the coming together of many wild things to make a ferocious yet beautiful beast. This wine can only be produced in vintages where our Henry Ranch Cabernet Sauvignon and our Beckstoffer's Orchard Avenue Merlot ripen within two days of each other, so that they may be fermented together in the same small open top vessel.

This gorgeous co-ferment is lovingly hand tended throughout the fermentation process and 22 month aging. It is a powerful and bold red blend with a unique ferocity unlike anything else we create. It is made in a style that will readily age for many years. A deep bouquet of blackcurrants, plum and Pompona vanilla orchids, with a full bodied mouth feel dripping with tannins, and flavors of Amarena cherries, and blueberry with generous notes of creamy melted chocolate on the finish. Drink now through 2030.
